EXHIBIT A 2.02.075 Standing committees - Established. The following committees are established: A. Finance and Administrative Services. General areas of responsibility for this committee shall be budget, taxation and purchasing issues, personnel policies and union negotiations; B. Planning and Development. General areas of responsibility for this committee shall be zoning, development, stormwater, and fire; C. Public Works and Health. General areas of responsibility for this committee shall be road construction and vacations, new construction, remodeling, public utilities issues, solid waste and health-related issues referred to the committee by the health board, public health advisory board, or health department; D. <u>Climate Action and Natural Resources</u>. General areas of responsibility for this committee shall be climate change mitigation and adaptation, water, forestry, agriculture, fishery and mineral issues; E. Criminal Justice and Public Safety.
