Whatcom County Council will have a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its and may affend the following at its July 9, 2019, meeting, or at a later or other or CEDURES AND TITLE 23 (CHAP-TER 23.10) UPDATING THE REF-ERENCED CRITICAL AREAS OR-DINANCE (AB2019-316). This or-clinance amends WCC to clarify what type of permit is needed to remove trees within the Lake Whatcom Watershed and the Water Resource Protection overlay districts (Lake Padden, Samish, and Whatcom watershedsl in order to monitor tree canopy retention through the requirement to apply for a tree removal permit. It also amends the Shore-line Master Program (SMP) to adopt the recently amended Critical Areas Ordinance (CAO) regarding the defi-nition of 'hazard tree' and directs Planning & Development Services (PDS) to submit it to the Department of Ecology for their review and ap-proval. INTERIM ORDINANCE IM-POSING AN INTERIM MORATORI-UM ON THE ACCEPTANCE AND PROCESSING OF APPLICATIONS AND PERMITS FOR NEW OF EX-PANDED FACILITIES IN THE CHERRY POINT URBAN GROWTH AREA THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF WHICH WOULD BE THE SHIP MENT OF UNREFINED FOSSIL FUELS NOT TO BE PROCESSED AT CHERRY POINT (AB2019) 339): This interim moratorium prohibits the filing, acceptance, and crocessing of new applications for conversion of land or water, new building or structure permits, or other County permits or authorizations in the Cherry Point Urban Growth Area for new or expanded facilities whose purpose is to facilitate the increased shipment of unrefined fossil fuels not to be processed at Cherry Point, unless the applications: 1. Were filed and complete prior to the effective date of this ordinance and vested pursuant to Washington statutes: 2. Were for building permits for remodels, maintenance, or re-pairs of existing structures where no increased capacity for shipping unrefined fossil fuels not to be precessed at Cherry Point will result; or

This interim ordinance shall be effective for not longer than six months following its effective date, but may be renewed for one of more sucmonth periods if subspquent public hearings are hold and duent public hearings are figld and indings of fact are made prior to each renewal. INTERIM ORDINANCE ADOPTING INTERIM ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE SITING, ESTABLISHMENT, AND OPERATION OF TEMPORARY HOMELESS FACILITIES (AB2019-340): This ordinance adopts interim zoning regulations for the sting, establishment, and operation of temporary tent encampments; and sets twelve months as the effective period of the interim zoning regulations to allow the County to study the land use impacts of such uses. This ordinance shall be effective for not longer than twelve months folkwing its effective date, but may be renewed for one or more byelve-month periods if subsequent public hearings are held and findings of lact are made prior to each renew-al.
