WHEREAS, the initial construction of the East Whatcom Regional Resource Center (EWRRC) was substantially completed in 2011; and

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2016 the Whatcom County Council approved Ordinance 2016-004 to increase the original project budget to expand the building to accommodate a food bank and multi-use facility; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2018 the Whatcom County Council approved Resolution 2018-025 to increase the Real Estate Excise Tax I (REET I) Fund contribution to the project budget by an additional \$115,000 to supplement funding needed for the full design and build out of the EWRRC food bank distribution center and multi-use programming community space; and

WHEREAS, construction of the second EWRRC building began in early 2019 and the Opportunity Council has raised \$2,705,000 towards the \$2,877,000 project budget, including the County's prior commitment of \$415,000; and

WHEREAS, the funding gap of \$172,000 will be fulfilled through an additional contribution from the REET I Fund and will provide the necessary funds to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, the project budget must be increased to afford the necessary expenditure authority to spend these additional funds

On February 9, 2016 the Whatcom County Council approved Ordinance 2016-004 to increase the original project budget to expand the building to accommodate a food bank and multi-use facility and on July 10, 2018 the Whatcom County Council approved Resolution 2018-025 to increase the REET I Fund contribution to the project budget by an additional \$115,000 to supplement funding needed for the full design and build out of the EWRRC food bank distribution center and multi-use programming community space.

Construction of the second EWRRC building began in early 2019: a 4,900 square-foot, one-story facility for multiple community uses, including a food bank distribution center with refrigerated storage space, as well as multi-purpose meeting and activity rooms. To date, the Opportunity Council raised \$2,705,000 towards the \$2,877,0000 project budget for the second phase construction (including \$415,000 county investment from REET funds) leaving a funding gap of \$172,000.

In September 2018 the bid opening for this construction expansion project resulted in all bids being well over the pre-bid estimated construction costs. The Opportunity Council was able to work with the low bidder to reduce the scope of work primarily by postponing the third building that was included in the bid call and reducing other construction costs. A funding gap of \$172,000 to complete the revised scope of work will be resolved with this additional REET funding.
