Whatcom County Council will have public hearings, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its September 24, 2019, meeting, or at a later date: ORDINANCE ES-TABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT FOR PORTIONS OF EAST SMITH ROAD AND EVERSON GOSHEN ROAD (2019-450): This ordinance establishes the speed limits as follows: 35 MPH on E. Smith Road, from 1000 feet west of Everson Goshen Road to 1000 feet east of Everson Goshen Road, Sections 25, 26, 35, 36, Township 39 North, Range 3 East, W.M.; 35 MPH on Everson Goshen Road, from 1000 feet north of E. Smith Road to 1000 feet south of E. Smith Road, Sections 25, 26, 35, 36, Township 39 North, Range 3 East, W.M. The County Engineer will install the appropriate signs and the Sheriff and State Patrol will be notified. ORDI-NANCE AMENDING WCC 8.13, SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL DIS-TRICT, REGARDING THE SOLID WASTE EXCISE PRIVILEGE TAX (2019-458): This ordinance amends WCC 8.13.030, Excise privdege tax levied to implement a revenue neutral conversion of the tax, for solid waste collection compa nies, from \$8.50 per ton to 3.3% of invoice, thus ensuring that taxes coltected exactly equal taxes remitted.
