Whatcom County Council will have a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its and may amend the following at its July 9, 2019, meeting, or at a later date: ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WHATCOM COUNTY CODE (WCC) TITLE 20 (CHAPTERS 20.51 AND 20.71) PERTAINING TO TREE REMOVAL PERMIT PROCEDURES AND TITLE 23 (CHAPTER 23.10) UPDATING THE REFERENCED CRITICAL AREAS ORDINANCE (AB2019.3161) This ordinance amends WCC to clarify what type of permit is needed to remove trees within the Lake Whatcom Watrees within the Lake Whalcom Wa-tershed and the Water Resource Protection overlay districts (Lake Padden, Samish, and Whatcom watersheds) in order to monitor tree cancey retention through the recuirement to apply for a free removal permit. It also amends the Shore-line Master Program (SMP) to adopt the recently amended Critical Areas Ordinance (CAO) regarding the defi-nition of 'hazard tree' and directs Planning & Development Services (POSI to submit it to the Department of Ecology for their review and approval.
