#### **AB2019-324 QUARTERLY REPORT FROM WHATCOM COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS** 1.

Jon Hutchings, Public Works Department Director, introduced new staff in the department. He submitted information (on file), reported, and answered questions on the summer road construction program, road closure barriers, information available to the public on the department website, the Birch Bay Drive & Pedestrian Facility Project, and website information on each project's funding source.

### AB2019-323 PUBLIC WORKS STAFF TO PRESENT A BRIEF PRESENTATION 2. ABOUT THE EAST SMITH ROAD AND HANNEGAN ROAD INTERSECTION **IMPROVEMENTS**

Jim Karcher, Public Works Department, submitted handouts (on file) and reported on an upcoming project at the E. Smith Road and Hannegan Road intersection. He described two alignment options for the project and answered questions on engaging property owners in the area, when they will decide on an option, plans for detours during construction, and minimum diameter requirements for a roundabout.
