PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Whatcom County Council will hold a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on July 11, 2023, or at a later date: **ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSITION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF WHATCOM COUNTY PURSUANT TO RCW 82.14.450 AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX OF TWO-TENTHS OF ONE PERCENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND JUSTICE FACILITIES AND SERVICES, INCLUDING BEHAVIORAL HEALTH, SUPPORTIVE HOUSING, PUBLIC SAFETY, AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS (AB2023-415)**: This ordinance provides for submission of a proposition to the qualified electors of Whatcom County, pursuant to RCW 82.14.450, authorizing the collection of a local sales and use tax of two-tenths of one percent for the purpose of providing funds for costs associated with public health, safety and justice facilities and services, including behavioral health, supportive housing, public safety, and criminal justice facilities and programs. The ordinance also establishes rules and procedures related to the following: deposit of proceeds; eligible expenditures; inter-jurisdictional and stakeholder coordination; authority to bond; subsequent Implementation Plans and Implementation Plan amendments; oversight, accountability, and transparency. This ordinance is scheduled for introduction by the County Council on June 26, 2023.

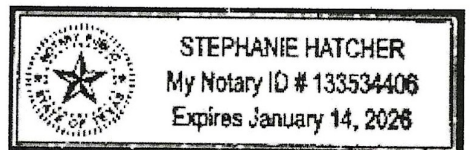
