One of the key priorities in the Healthy Children's Fund ordinance and implementation plan is to stabilize the childcare market by both making it more affordable for families and by helping businesses reach a more sustainable financial state and build potential for growth.

On Wednesday, November 6th you received a briefing from Healthy Children's Fund program staff and our Childcare Consultant regarding subsidy and rate augmentation, the two strategies to address childcare stabilization. The goal of the discussion on November 19th is to receive council direction on the proposed plan to serve families with children 0-5 from 75%-85% SMI with a child care tuition discount and providers with rate augmentation for each Working Connection's enrolled child they serve age 0-3.

Based on feedback received from Councilmembers on November 6th, staff will provide the below recommendation for subsidies and rate augmentation for years 1 and 2. Council direction on staff recommendations and funding priorities are requested at this briefing.
