EXHIBIT A

3.08.060 Bids and proposals required.

Awards of contracts for the acquisition of materials, supplies, services, tools, equipment or rental of personal property and professional services exceeding \$40,000 will be based upon bids or proposals received in response to specifications and invitations to bid, except as provided below:

- A. Sole source purchases shall not be required to go through competitive bidding. A purchase may be determined to be sole source by the county executive or designee when the bidding process would be futile because only one bidder could respond to the invitation.
- B. In the event of an emergency when the public interest or property of the county would suffer material injury or damage by delay, upon an order of the county executive declaring the existence of such emergency and reciting the facts constituting same, the requirements governing competitive bids with reference to any purchase or contract may be waived pursuant to RCW <u>36.32.270</u>.
- C. Public works projects involving funds not exceeding the amount allowed under RCW <u>39.04.155</u>, or any successor statute, may be completed utilizing the small works roster contract award process pursuant to WCC <u>3.08.095</u>.
- D. Acquisition is from another public entity.
- E. Contract does not require use of county funds.
- F. The procurement of professional services may be completed utilizing the consultant roster award process pursuant to WCC <u>3.08.096</u>.
- G. <u>Unless required by law, Contracts is for services with from an non-profit organizations and where</u> contract terms limit payment to the reimbursement of direct wages and benefits, supplies, <u>beneficiary payments</u> and overhead at the greater of 10 percent or the approved federal indirect overhead rate <u>calculated on direct costs</u>. <u>This clause shall be in effect until June 18, 2024.</u>
- H. Contract is for public defender services (RCW 36.32.245)
- I. Contracts supporting low income housing projects (RCW 36.32.415)
- J. Contracts for election materials containing the names of candidates and/or ballot titles (RCW 36.32.245).
