Lots of my neighbors and chosen family have been through the legal system, and I've seen from first-hand experience how hard it can be to recover from that. Lots of these individuals need better mental health support, financial support, or just better reintegration support in general. Down the road I hope to get my Master's to become a medical examiner, and something that I hope to do when I get that title is to make myself a pillar of my community. To better understand vulnerable populations and help find preventative ways to keep them out of harm's way and off the table. I think this position would not only help me continue to grow my skill set in learning to be a better advocate and member of my community, but would also allow me to provide a unique perspective and suggestions to our county's justice system. This opportunity was first presented to me by my professor Dr. Michael McHenry at Whatcom Community College and when I heard of it I thought it sounded like such a great way to become more involved in my county's government, and arguably more importantly, help my community in a more hands-on way that I thought I asn't possible at my age.
