(AB2015-175): This ordinance establishes WCC 2.118 to create the Whatcom County Wildlife Advisory Committee to advise the Whatcom County Planning and Development Service Department staff and the Whatcom County Council on wildlife and habitat issues as they relate to the Whatcom County Comprehensive Plan, with the goal of integrating wildlife management and protection into the community planning process.



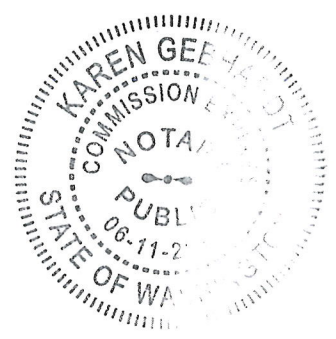
