Attached is a grant amendment between Whatcom County and Washington State Department of Health for your review and signature. This amendment adds or increases funding and/or revises scopes of work for the Child Well-care Visit Video Project, Workforce Development, Foundational Public Health Services, Syringe Services, On-site Sewage, and Recreational Shellfish Programs, as indicated in the table below.

- **Background and Purpose**
The Consolidated Contract defines the joint and cooperative relationship between Whatcom County and the Washington State Department of Health for the delivery and funding of various public health services in Whatcom County.
- **Funding Amount and Source**
This amendment adds \$1,948,136. Total funding for this grant is \$16,258,233 and is provided by state and federal resources. These funds will be included in the 2024 budget. Council authorization is required per RCW 39.34.030(2) for agreements between public agencies.
- **Differences from Previous Contracts**
This amendment adds or revises funding and/or statements of work for the following programs:

Workforce Development	Extends funding through 12/31/2024 and updates the SOW
Foundational Public Health Services	\$1,921,500
Syringe Services Program	Revises funding source and updates the SOW
On-Site Sewage Local Management Plan Implementation	\$23,636
Recreational Shellfish Activities	\$3,000
