## WHATCOM COUNTY PROCLAMATION OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Whatcom County Sheriff's Office Division of Emergency Management has reported to the Whatcom County Executive, beginning December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025, that Severe Winter Storms, High Winds, Flooding, Mudslides, and Landslide risk conditions exist across Whatcom County, and,

WHEREAS, this incident is a threat to life and property, and demands immediate action, and,

WHEREAS, persons and property will be damaged unless further efforts are taken to reduce the threat to life, and

WHEREAS, this constitutes an emergency as defined by the Whatcom County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and necessitates the utilization of powers granted pursuant to the Whatcom County Charter and RCW 38.52.070(2); therefore,

BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE WHATCOM COUNTY EXECUTIVE that an emergency exists in Whatcom County; therefore, Whatcom County departments are authorized to do the following:


- (1) Enter into contracts and incur obligations necessary to combat such emergency situations to protect the health and safety of persons; and,
- (2) Provide appropriate emergency assistance to the victims of such disaster; and,
- (3) Other actions, as deemed appropriate by the Director of Emergency Management or his designee.

Each Whatcom County department is authorized to exercise the powers vested under this proclamation in the light of the exigencies of an extreme emergency situation without regard to time-consuming procedures and formalities prescribed by law (excepting mandatory constitutional requirements). This Proclamation shall remain in effect until the issuance of a Termination Proclamation by the Whatcom County Executive.

**WHATCOM COUNTY  
PROCLAMATION OF EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS, on December 9, 2025,** Whatcom County Executive Satpal Sidhu issued a Proclamation of Emergency for the Winter Weather Event Dec25-4783, for Whatcom County in response to severe weather storms, high winds, flooding, mudslides, and landslide risk conditions across Whatcom County, and

**WHEREAS,** significant portions of Whatcom County experienced catastrophic flooding which in turn resulted in evacuations of the cities of Everson, Nooksack, Ferndale, and Sumas as well as unincorporated portions of Whatcom County, and

**WHEREAS,** Whatcom County Code 8.15 establishes a comprehensive countywide solid waste system for handling all solid waste generated in the unincorporated areas of the county and generated in cities within the county; and

**WHEREAS,** WCC 8.15 requires the county to direct the in-county processing and disposal of all solid waste generated within the unincorporated area of the county and generated within cities to a disposal site or sites consistent with the code and the Comprehensive Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Plan; and

**WHEREAS,** flood related waste requires management by trained health professionals, and whereas Whatcom County Health & Community Services serves as the countywide health department responsible for health-related activities in unincorporated Whatcom County and within Whatcom County cities; and

**WHEREAS,** it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and to prevent land, air and water pollution, that additional or alternate disposal sites be designated on an emergency basis, as recommended by the Whatcom County Solid Waste Manager; and

**WHEREAS,** it is further necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for Whatcom County Health and Community Services and its contractors to expedite and monitor the processing of waste; and

**WHEREAS,** the County Executive may, for a period of no longer than 60 consecutive days, designate additional or alternate disposal sites that do not comply with all the requirements of WCC 8.15.030; and

**WHEREAS,** the alternate disposal sites shall be established in accordance with the Whatcom County Debris Management Plan; and

**WHEREAS,** the situation constitutes an emergency as defined by the Whatcom County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and Whatcom County Code WCC 8.15.030 (F); therefore,

**BE IT PROCLAIMED** the Whatcom County Executive authorizes disposal for flood debris only, at three temporary debris disposal sites at:

- 1) Recycling and Disposal Services, 4916 La Bounty, Ferndale
- 2) Republic Services, 1524 Slater Road, Ferndale
- 3) Stremler Gravel Site, 9626 Swanson Road, Sumas

Whatcom County Health and Community Services Department is authorized to exercise the powers vested under this proclamation in light of the exigencies of an extreme emergency situation and with the powers granted through WCC 8.15. This Proclamation shall terminate after 60 consecutive days unless otherwise rescinded.
