

#### **Healthy Children's Fund**



The Healthy Children's Fund is a voter-approved property tax levy that generates approximately \$10 million per year for investments in early childhood learning and care and for the support of vulnerable children.


Healthy Children's Fund dollars are intended to be spent in alignment with 10 strategies that were developed in collaboration with community partners and adopted by the Whatcom County Council as part of the implementation plan (March 2023).

The fund aims to create a county where:

- More children are safe, healthy and ready to learn.
