PROPOSED BY: Public Works - Engineering 1 2 INTRODUCTION DATE: 03/22/2022 3 4 ORDINANCE NO. 2022-030 5 6 REMOVING A SCHOOL SPEED ZONE ON HANNEGAN ROAD 7 WHEREAS, the Whatcom County Council is authorized under RCW 46.61.440 to 8 9 establish school speed zones on certain County Roads; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the school zone and speed limit are currently established on Hannegan 12 Road and posted as "35 miles per hour, when children are present"; and 13 WHEREAS, the Meridian School District has notified the County Engineer that no 14 children walk or bike to school in this zone; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the Meridian School District has determined that there is no safe 17 walk/bike routes for students living within the normal one mile radius walk/bike zone as 18 established by the Safe Routes to Schools program; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the Meridian School District offers bussing to all students under the Safe 21 22 Routes to Schools program; and 23 WHEREAS, the Meridian School District has requested that the school speed zone on 24 25 Hannegan Road from 500 feet north of Ten Mile Road to E. Hemmi Road be removed; and 26 WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office Traffic Sergeant has express support for the removal 27 of this School Speed Zone; and 28 29 30 WHEREAS, the County Engineer has agreed to remove this school speed zone; and 31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Whatcom County Council that the 32 school speed zone on Hannegan Road from 500 feet north of Ten Mile Road to E. Hemmi 33 Road in Sections 16 and 17, Township 39 North, Range 3 East, W.M., be removed; and 34 35 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Whatcom County Council that Whatcom 36 County Code Section 10.04.095 is amended as follows: 37 38 B. A school zone and speed limit shall be set and posted as "35 miles per hour, when 39 children are present," in the following location: 40 41 Meridian School District 42 43 Meridian Middle School Hannegan Road from 44 500 feet north of Ten 45 Mile Road to Hemmi 46 Road, Sections 16 and 47 48 17, Township 39 North, Range 3 East. 49 50 51
