7. Please describe your occupation (or former occupation if retired), qualifications, professional	I am a coastal geologist at Natural Systems Design + Coastal Geologic Services here in Bellingham. I received my masters degree in coastal geology from Western Washington University while working with my advisor Dr. Eric Grossman of the United States Geologic Survey studying coastal bluff erosion, sediment transport, and wave runup in Puget Sound. I also have a bachelors degree in geology from University of Oregon. I am a licensed geologist in the Washington State and am also UAV licensed

operator and an approved biologist by WDFW.

Through my work as a coastal geologist I have completed several sea level rise vulnerability assessments, including one for all of Puget Sound, and also assisted in the Whatcom County Compound Flood Vulnerability Assessment. I have worked on many nearshore restoration projects, such as bulkhead removals, as well as some local projects including Little Squalicum Estuary, Boulevard Park Beach, Salish Landing, Birch Bay Berm, and Way Point Park. Additionally, I work with the Northwest Straits Foundation to conduct Shore Friendly site assessments all across Puget Sound including dozens in Whatcom County.

8. Please describe why you're interested in serving on this Advisory Group.

I am passionate about protecting and managing shorelines and would like to join the advisory group to be more apart of the marine protection and restoration locally in Whatcom County. I feel that I would be able to provide informed feedback and recommendations on policies and plans that may impact marine resources through my experience working with government agencies, non-profits, and directly with homeowners in Puget Sound and specifically in Whatcom County. There are a lot of complex marine issues in Whatcom County and I would like be apart of working on finding feasible, sustainable, and creative solutions.
