This ordinance will amend Whatcom County Code 9.08.020, Unlawful Exposure, to allow an exception when a parent is breastfeeding a child. This resolution was introduced on March 23, 2021. **ORDINANCE IMPOSING AN INTERIM MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE AND PROCESSING OF APPLICATIONS AND PERMITS FOR NEW OR EXPANDED OUTDOOR RECREATIONAL CANNABIS GROWING AND/OR PROCESSING FACILITIES (AB2021-190)**. This ordinance prohibits, on an interim basis, the filing, acceptance, or processing of new applications for conversion of land or water, new building or structure permits, or other County permits or authorizations for outdoor recreational marijuana production and/or processing facilities. The interim moratorium shall not apply to applications that were filed and determined to be complete prior to the effective date of this ordinance and vested pursuant to Washington statutes, or those for minor tenant improvement permits associated with existing, permitted facilities. This interim ordinance shall be effective for not longer than six months following its effective date, but may be renewed for one or more six-month periods if subsequent public hearings are held and findings of fact are made prior to each renewal. This ordinance was introduced on March 23, 2021.

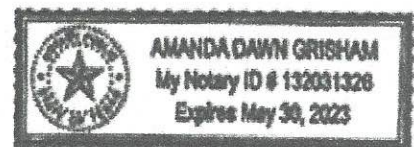
