PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Whatcom County Council will have a public hearing on the following at its May 9, 2023, meeting, or at a later date:

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A REVISED SYSTEM OF ASSESSMENT FOR DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 7 (AB2023-231)

This ordinance adopts a revised system of assessment to provide revenue for the Drainage Improvement District No. 7. The existing method of assessment is based solely on a relative ratio per acre per lot and does not take into consideration the greater contribution of runoff from and the greater benefit associated with conveying runoff away from a higher value asset within the District. The proposed system of assessment will be based on a combination of a relative ratio per acre (including minimum fee for lots smaller than one-acre) and a relative ratio of improvement value (per Assessor) per lot within the District. The revised system is being proposed to improve the equity of property assessments. This ordinance was introduced April 11, 2023.

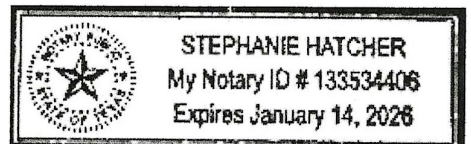
