The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its January 28, 2025, meeting: **ORDINANCE** (2025meeting: ORDINANCE (2025-004) ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO WHATCOM COUNTY CODE TITLE 20, ZONING (AB2024-874): This ordinance amends What-com County Code Title 20, Zoning, Section 20.34.400 to, under certain conditions, increase the allowed maximum beight of structures from 244imum height of structures from 24 to 25 or 30 feet, depending on its prox-imity to shoreline. This ordinance was introduced on January 14, 2025.
