MPH School Speed Zones on Bennett Drive and Alderwood Avenue for

**Alderwood Elementary School** 

#### **Requested Action**

Public Works respectfully requests that the County Council adopt the proposed ordinance to establish School Speed Zones on Bennett Drive from 300 feet north of Alderwood Avenue to 300 feet south of Alderwood Avenue, and on Alderwood Avenue from Bennett Drive to Hollywood Avenue.

### **Background and Purpose**

In collaboration with the Bellingham School District and Whatcom County Sheriff's Office Traffic Sergeant, Whatcom County Public Works is proposing to establish "20 Miles Per Hour, When Children are Present" School Speed Zones on Bennett Drive and Alderwood Avenue. The establishment of these school speed zones, where children walk or bike to school, would allow for safer travel for both the students and the traveling public. These low cost improvements are part of a wider partnership with the Bellingham School District to improve students travel under the Safe Routes to Schools program within the normal one mile radius walk/bike zone. Letters of support have been provided by: Superintendent of Bellingham Public Schools, Greg Baker; Sgt. Anthony Paz, Whatcom County Sheriff's Office Traffic Sergeant; and the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee.

#### Information

This ordinance will allow for the installation of school zone speed limit signs and is necessary to comply with RCW 46.61.440 to establish school speed zones on certain County roads.
