

## Potential Implementation Projects

### **Increase Access to Behavioral Health Services**

1. Increase capacity of effective existing programs to divert people from incarceration
2. Address shortages of BH service providers to expand service capacity
3. Explore options for outpatient “competency restoration” services

### **Bolster Re-entry Support Services**

4. Establish jail-based and community-based locations for coordinated re-entry support services
5. Ensure people leaving jail have transportation to a safe destination

### **Make Systems Changes with Local, Regional, & State Partners**

6. Increase communication and coordination between organizations
7. Make changes in court systems to reduce the number of people detained in jail before trial, provide options in lieu of bail
8. Advocate for a state waiver to allow use of Medicaid funds to pay for jail-based medical and behavioral health services
9. Work with state partners to increase access to inpatient competency restoration.

### **Expand Supportive Housing for People At Risk of Incarceration**

10. Ensure existing supportive housing programs are adequately staffed and equipped
11. Expand the number of permanent supportive housing options

### **Build a Safe & Humane Jail and Behavioral Health Facilities with Services to Help People Stay Out of Jail**

12. Build a safe and humane jail
13. Build a Behavioral Care Center to provide secure, short-term behavioral health treatment as an alternative to jail
14. Build a 23-hour Crisis Relief Center (24/7 Behavioral Health Urgent Care)
15. Research feasibility and desirability of building a secure detox facility in the region

### **Measure and Share Progress for Accountability and Transparency**

16. Collect data to measure progress toward desired outcomes
17. Develop a data dashboard for criminal legal system organizations to share data with one another and the public

- Anne Deacon Center for Hope (Crisis Stabilization Center)
- 23-hr Crisis Relief Center (open 24/7 to provide behavioral health urgent care)

## LaBounty (off Slater Road and I-5)

- **Horizontal jail** with booking area, medical, services
- Behavioral Care Center

## Civic Center (near Courthouse)

- Holding space for people waiting for attorney visits, court room access, etc.

## Champion (between Champion & York )

- Community Resource Center with re-entry support

### Irongate (Division Street)

- Anne Deacon Center for Hope (Crisis Stabilization Center)
- **Vertical jail** with booking area, medical, services
- Behavioral Care Center

### La Bounty (off Slater Rd. & I-5)

- *Sell the property*

### Civic Center (near Courthouse)

- Community Resource Center/Re-entry Support
- Holding space for people waiting for attorney visits, court room access, etc.

### Champion (between Champion & York)

- 23-hr. Crisis Relief Center (open 24/7 to provide behavioral health urgent care)
