This ordinance was introduced on June 4, 2024, RESOLUTION (2024-030) ADOPTING CHANGES TO WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 100.07 BIRCH BAY WATERSHED AND AQUATIC RESOURCES MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FUNDING MECHANISM, BY REVISING THE RATE STRUCTURE, SERVICE CHARGE ADJUSTMENTS AND EXEMPTIONS (COUNCIL ACTING AS THE WHATCOM COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL 20NE DISTRICT BOARD OF SUPERVISORS) (AB2024-350): This resolution adopts changes to WCC 100.07.
