**Requested Action**

Public Works respectfully requests that the Flood Control Zone District Board of Supervisors authorize the County Executive to sign this agreement.

**Background and Purpose**

The Whatcom Conservation District (WCD) provides local expertise and technical assistance to help landowners with non-dairy agricultural operations implement farm plans and best management practices that protect water quality. This agreement supplements WCD community outreach, water quality, and cost share programs to support PIC program objectives, including grant-funded technical assistance and outreach provided through a National Estuary Program Subrecipient Agreement (Whatcom County contract# 202307009-1).

The WCD will provide community outreach, financial assistance for agricultural best management practices, and water quality monitoring to support the Whatcom County PIC Program.

**Funding Amount and Source**

This interlocal agreement will provide \$77,000 to support PIC Program technical assistance and cost share. Funding for this agreement is included in the proposed 2026 Flood Control Zone District budget.
