Whatcom County Council will have a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its March 24, 2020, meeting, or at a later date:

ORDINANCE AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 16.20.065 ADVISORY GROUPS FOR WHATCOM COUNTY SHELLFISH PROTECTION DISTRICTS (AB2020-091): This ordinance removes term limits for Portage Bay and Drayton Harbor Shellfish Protection District advisory committee members. This provides an opportunity for interested advisory committee members to remain engaged in the committee after serving two terms.

RESOLUTION REGARDING APPLICATION FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) (AB2020-121): This resolution authorizes the County Executive to submit an application to the State of Washington for funding through a Community Development Block Grant. The purpose of the public hearing is to review community development and housing needs, inform citizens of the availability of funds and eligible uses of the state Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and receive comments on proposed activities, particularly from lower income persons residing in Whatcom County. \$131,227 is proposed to be available annually to Whatcom, Skagit and Island Counties, through the Opportunity Council, to fund public services that principally benefit low- and moderate-income persons. Comments on the county's and Opportunity Council's past performance and use of their 2019 CDBG Public Services Grant will also be received. The draft grant application, including an overview of the proposed public services, will be available for review at the Whatcom County Executive's office, Suite 108, 311 Grand Avenue, Bellingham, after April 9, 2020. Comments may also be submitted in writing to the Whatcom County Council until the public hearing has been closed. In addition to the public services grant, the County Council will review other CDBG funding opportunities, including the Economic Opportunities Grant Program, which proposes up to \$500,000 of available funding in 2020.

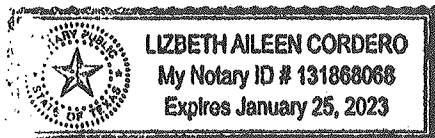
