A RESOLUTION GRANTING A QUITCLAIM RIGHT OF WAY DEED

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Whatcom County Council, through the County Executive, executes, notarizes and delivers said Quitclaim Deed to the City of Lynden.

Legal Description of Right of Way to be quitclaimed

All of Berthusen Road Right-of-Way and West Main Street Right-of-Way extending northerly 400 feet from the centerline of the intersection of Berthusen Road and West Main Street, along with that certain triangular land area abutted by Berthusen Road and West Main Street as depicted on Exhibit A. Also including any portion of West Main Street Right-of-Way at said intersection that is outside of city limits of the City of Lynden. All located in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 23 and the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 40 North, Range 2 East, W.M.
