Re:	Resolution to Declare Whatcom County Real Property as Surplus and Approve Transfer

Enclosed is a resolution requesting the approval of the surplus and transfer of Whatcom County real property to the Lummi Nation.

Requested Action

Public Works respectfully requests that the Whatcom County Council hold a public hearing and take action on the proposed resolution to approve the surplus and transfer of Whatcom County real property.

Background and Purpose

Per RCW 36.34.130 and Whatcom County Code 1.10.340, the Whatcom County Property Management Committee has recommended the surplus and transfer of Whatcom County real property, tax parcel number 390109 183088 0000, to the Lummi Nation, subject to recording a conservation easement on the property. The property was purchased for mitigation for the Birch Bay Drive and Pedestrian Facility Project. A requirement of the mitigation is for a conservation easement to be recorded on the title of the property. The conservation easement prohibits any future development of the property. The property was appraised and the property was valued at \$125,000 as encumbered by the conservation easement. However, it has been evaluated by Public Works and it has been determined that it has no further utility or value to Public Works as encumbered by the conservation easement and would be mutually beneficially for the property to be transferred to the Lummi Nation for no consideration.

Funding Amount and Source

The property would be transferred to the Lummi Nation for mutual benefits and no consideration will be paid.
