Enclosed for your review and signature is an interlocal agreement between Whatcom County and the City of Everson for reimbursement of the expense incurred by the installation of two road gates on Main Street in the City of Everson.

- Background and Purpose

Washington State, through its Department of Commerce, is providing funding to Whatcom County through the State Emergency Rapid Response Grant Program to support the county's efforts to provide essential community services and recovery assistance following the November 2021 state and federally declared flood disaster. This includes reimbursement for the installation of a set of emergency road gates in Everson.

Whatcom County Sheriff's Office Division of Emergency Management is administering the grant.
Period of Performance: July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.
