Nurse Family Partnership Agreement Amendment #3

Attached is a contract between Whatcom County and Washington State DCYF for your review and signature. This amendment increases funding for 'concrete goods' which Health and Community Services uses to provide retail gift cards to Nurse Family Partnership families for use on groceries, gas, and other essential needs.

#### Background and Purpose

This agreement provides funding for Health and Community Services' Nurse Family Partnership (NFP) Program. The NFP Program is an evidence-based, community health program that transforms the lives of vulnerable babies born to at-risk, first-time mothers. Nurses conduct home visits with pregnant and parenting mothers and educate parents on child development, safety, and health.

### Funding Amount and Source

This amendment adds \$8,840. Total agreement funding is \$827,677.20 and will be included in the 2025 budget. Council authorization is required per RCW 39.34.030(2) for agreements between public agencies.
