Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its January 28, 2020, meeting:

ORDINANCE (2020-002) AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE CHAPTERS 11.16 AND 11.20 TO PROTECT LAKE SAMISH SHORELINE PROPERTIES AND LAKE SAMISH WATER RECREATION (AB2019-480): This ordinance amends boating and swimming regulations for Lake Samish; specifically speed regulations (11.16.030) and regulations related to activities allowed within specific distances from the shoreline (WCC 11.20.010C). Council introduced above at its December 3, 2019, meeting.

ORDINANCE (2020-001) AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE, 16.30 LAKE WHATCOM STORMWATER UTILITY FUNDING MECHANISM, CHANGING THE DATE FOR COLLECTION OF CAPITAL FACILITY CHARGES FROM JANUARY 1, 2020 TO JANUARY 1, 2021 (AB2019-614): This ordinance amends Ordinance 2019-053, Lake Whatcom Stormwater Utility Funding Mechanism, to initiate the Capital Facilities Charges in January 2021 rather than January 2020. The requested time extension is needed to develop an effective collection process and to clarify ambiguous language included in Section 11 of Whatcom County Code 16.30. Council introduced above at its December 3, 2019, meeting.

ORDINANCE (2020-003) AMENDING THE 2020 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 3, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,586,506 (AB2020-020): This ordinance requests funding from the General Fund for: \$300,000 Opportunity Council Housing Rehab grant program; \$52,454 in Health to fund Next Generation Project; \$6,190 in Health for Fund Perinatal Support Services; \$445,512 to fund Cabree and Neptune Beach/Sigurdsson conservation easements; \$782,350 to fund Plantation Indoor Range HVAC and roof replacement projects. Council introduced above at its January 14, 2020, meeting.

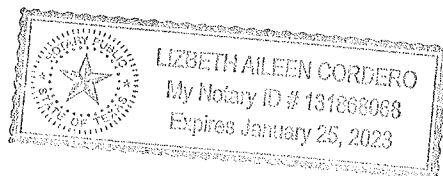
