THIS AMENDMENT is to the Contract between Whatcom County and Ideal Option PLLC, dated January 26, 2022 and designated "Whatcom County Contract No 202201014" (the 'Contract') In consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived, the parties agree to the following

This Amendment assigns all of Ideal Option's rights and obligations under the Contract to Assignee, MXD PLLC. MXD PLLC accepts all of Assignor's (Ideal Option) obligations, responsibilities and duties under the Contract and all of Assignor's rights, title and interest in and to the Contract

This Amendment extends the term of this Agreement through June 30, 2025 with an option to extend through December 31, 2025 and then again through December 31, 2026 Notice of the intention to extend the Agreement shall be presented in writing by either party Any period of extension must be by mutual acceptance.

The maximum compensation for this six-month period will not exceed \$138,921.00

Unless specifically amended by this agreement, all other terms and conditions of the original contract shall remain in full force and effect

This Amendment/Assignment Plan takes effect January 1, 2025, regardless of the date of signature Upon effect of this Assignment, Ideal Option PLLC is fully released from any and all obligations under the Contract, except as indicated in section 44.1 of the Contract



Enclosed are two (2) originals of a contract reassignment and renewal between Whatcom County, Ideal Option and MXD PLLC (Dr. Martin Dubek) for your review and signature.

■ **Background and Purpose**

Ideal Option was awarded the bid for Physician Services via the RFP process in 2021. They were the sole bidders for this contract. Recently, Ideal Option informed the County of their intent not to renew next year. Instead, they would like to reassign the contract to Dr. Martin Dubek, the doctor who provides the Physician Services for the Jail on their behalf. Dr. Dubek has accepted this reassignment through June 2025, with the option of renewing for a total of 2 more years. Reassigning this contract to Dr. Dubek will continue to meet the legal requirement that "Corrections Facilities must provide medical care that matches the standard of care in the community".

■ **Funding Amount and Source**

Funding will come from the approved 2025 Corrections Bureau budget with a maximum 6-month compensation of \$138,921.00.

■ **Differences from Previous Contract**

Ideal Option is reassigning the contract to MXD PLLC (Dr. Martin Dubek).
