E A S E M E N T

THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH: That G. E. AMUNDSEN

the Grantor, herein for consideration of the benefits to accrue to grantor by reason of the construction and maintenance of a drainage ditch through the property hereinafter described, does hereby grant and convey to Whatcom County, Washington, a PERPETUAL EASEMENT for a drainage ditch over the following described real estate in Whatcom County, Washington, to-wit:

NORTHEAST QUARTER, SOUTHWEST QUARTER (NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$) OF SECTION 2,
TOWNSHIP 38 NORTH, RANGE 2 EAST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN.

Said easement to be 30 feet in width and to run over, through and across the following described land:

BEGINNING SOUTH (S) 1,320 FEET MORE OR LESS AND WEST (W) 520 FEET MORE OR LESS FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 38 NORTH, RANGE 2 EAST; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY (NWly) 100 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY (NEly) FOLLOWING PRESENT DITCH TO ROAD; ALL IN SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 38 NORTH, RANGE 2 EAST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN.

Said easement being for the purpose of cleaning out the existing ditch. This document is written as a correction for Easement No. 971934, which was written for the same above-stated purpose.
