COUNCIL ACTION TAKEN

The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its May 5, 2020 meeting: **ORDINANCE (2020-022) TO PROVIDE PERMITTING RELIEF TO FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS (AB2020-189)**; This ordinance will amend Whatcom County Code 24.03.040(B) to add the following: Permits with expiration dates between March 1, 2020 and February 28, 2021 shall be extended from 12 months to 18 months for businesses billed under the following: UFS 1546 (taverns); 8461 (simple menu food establishments); 8466 (moderate menu food establishments); 8468 and 8470 (complex menu food establishments); and 8471 (food establishment bars and additional kitchens). This ordinance was introduced on April 21, 2020.

This ordinance was introduced on May 5, 2020. **ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2020 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 7, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000 (SUPERSEDES ORD. NO. 2020-008) (AB2020-195)**; This ordinance requests funding from the General Fund to appropriate \$250,000 in Non-Departmental to fund COVID-19 response. This ordinance was introduced on May 5, 2020. **ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2020 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET REQUEST NO. 8, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,155,821 (SUPERSEDES ORD. NO. 2020-012) (AB202-196)**; This ordinance appropriates funding as follows: \$250,000 from the General Fund to fund COVID-19 response; \$905,821 from the Health Department Homeless Housing Fund to COVID-19 Outbreak Emergency Housing Project from grant proceeds. 19 EMERGENCY RESPONSE FUND AND ESTABLISHING A BUDGET FOR THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY RESPONSE FUND (SUPERSEDES ORD. NO. 2020-016) (AB2020-197): This ordinance establishes a new special revenue fund titled "COVID-19 Emergency Response Fund" and appropriates \$1,750,000 in the fund. This ordinance was introduced on May 5, 2020. ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2020 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 10, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,000,000 (SUPERSEDES ORD. NO. 2020-018) (AB2020-198): This ordinance amends the 2020 Whatcom County Budget to appropriate \$3,000,000 to the COVID-19 response activities. This ordinance was introduced on May 5, 2020. ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2020 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 11, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$154,946 (SUPERSEDES ORD. NO. 2020-020) (AB2020-199): This ordinance appropriates \$154,946 in Non-Departmental to fund COVID-19 related urgent housing needs through Opportunity Council Public Services Program. This ordinance was introduced on May 5, 2020. ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INTERFUND LOAN TO FINANCE CASH FLOW COVID-19 EMERGENCY RESPONSE (REPLACES ORD. NO. 2020-015 AND ORD. NO. 2020-017) (AB2020-200): This ordinance requests authorization for a \$4 million interfund loan from the Public Utilities Improvement (EDI) Fund to the COVID-19 Emergency Response Fund to finance cash flow needs. This ordinance was introduced on May 5, 2020. ORDINANCE (INTERIM) ESTABLISHING A COVID-19 INTERIM ECONOMIC RECOVERY PLAN TO RESPOND TO THE ECONOMIC CRISIS WITHIN WHATCOM COUNTY CAUSED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC (AB2020-204): This ordinance establishes a COVID-19 interim economic recovery plan to respond to the economic crisis within Whatcom County caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.
