(AB2025-140): Petitioners seek to vacate the county's legal rights to open the road or portion of a road described as follows: All that certain portion of County Road Number 281, Camp 2 Road, lying in front of and adjoining Lot 36 and 37 Block 1, "Plat of Cain's Lake" according to the plat thereof, recorded in Volume 7 of Plats Pages 61 and 62, records of Whatcom County, Washington. Excepting therefrom: The Southwesterly 5 feet of said Lot 37, Block 1 as measured by a line drawn 5 feet Northeasterly from and parallel to the Southwesterly line of said Lot 37, Block 1. Being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Southeasterly corner of said Lot 36 Block 1; thence along the Southeasterly line of said Lot 36 and the Northwesterly right-of-way line of said County Road 281, Camp 2 Road. 
