On April 29, 2025, the Whatcom County Council reviewed and approved your *Outdoor Musical Entertainment, Amusements, and Assemblies Permit* application for the July 12, 2025 Strings and Things Music Festival event at the Point Roberts Marina, 713 Simundson Drive, Point Roberts, WA, <u>subject to compliance with the \$5,000 surety bond</u> requirement (see AB2025-285).
