The Whatcom County Council will hold a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on February 25, 2025, or at a later date: ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO WHATCOM COUNTY CODE TITLES 20 & 22 TO ENACT SSB 5290 REGARDING LOCAL PROJECT REVIEW (AB2025-059): This ordinance adopts amendments to Whatcom County Code Titles 20 & 22 to enact SSB 5290 regarding local project review and fix some additional deficiencies in Title 22. This ordinance was introduced on January 14, 2025. ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A REVISION TO THE UNIFIED FEE SCHEDULE (AB2025-145): This ordinance revises the Unified Fee Schedule to accommodate changes to the Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Ordinance and Whatcom County Code 2.27A. This ordinance was introduced on February 11, 2025. ORDINANCE AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 2.27A, AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES (AIS) (AB2025-147): This ordinance revises Whatcom County Code 2.27A, Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) to create new risk-based classes of watercraft. This ordinance was introduced on February 11, 2025.

The Whatcom County Council will consider adopting and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on February 25, 2025, or at a later date: ORDINANCE AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 2.123 FORESTRY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (AB2025-120): This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code 2.123 to revise the composition of committee membership, stagger membership terms, and clarify the committee's scope of work. This ordinance was introduced on February 11, 2025. ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 2.05, ONSITE SEWAGE SYSTEM REGULATIONS (AB2025-149): This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code 24.05, Onsite Sewage System Regulations, to adopt changes required by Washington State administrative code WAC 246-272A and to reflect onsite sewage system management best practices. This ordinance was introduced on February 11, 2025. ORDINANCE CLOSING THE SHALLOW SHORE CULVERT RELOCATION FUND 3917 (AB2025-160). This ordinance closes the Shallow Shore Culvert Relocation Fund 3971 and returns the remaining funds of \$172,283.99 to the Real Estate Excise Tax II fund. This ordinance was introduced on February 11, 2025. ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROJECT BUDGET FOR THE NEW PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND JUSTICE FACILITY, REQUEST NO. 7 (AB2025-162). This ordinance appropriates an additional \$1,000,000 of expenditure authority to fund critical upcoming consultant contracts including but not limited to owner's representative services, wetland mitigation consulting evolecthical engineering, and traffic analysis, for a new project budged of \$10,816,280. This ordinance was introduced on February 11, 2025. ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 2, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,751,265 (AB2025-164); This ordinance amends the 2025 Whatcom County Budget as follows: From the General Fund: appropriate \$76,500 in Council to fund Professional Services for Investigative Committee; appropriate \$12,500 in District Court to fund increases for Whatcom Dispute Resolution Center contract; appropriate \$52,500 in Health to fund Sustainable
