Enclosed is a cost reimbursement agreement amendment between the Whatcom County Flood Control Zone District (FCZD) and the City of Everson (City) for your review and signature.

#### **Requested Action**

Public Works respectfully requests that the County Executive and Council, acting as the FCZD Board of Supervisors, approve an amendment to the Cost Reimbursement Agreement with the City of Everson to increase budget for participation in the Floodplain Integrated Planning (FLIP) process including participation on the FLIP Steering Committee, FLIP Team, and FLIP Reach Teams.

#### **Background and Purpose**

The Cities of Everson, Nooksack and Sumas (Small Cities) are represented in the FLIP planning process by a consultant from Reichart and Ebe (R&E). The FCZD was awarded '21-'23 biennium and '23-'25 biennium Floodplains by Design (FbD) grants from the Department of Ecology for the Nooksack River: Floodplains that Work – Phase 2 and Phase 3 projects, respectively, that includes funding to support participation of Small City representatives in the FLIP planning process (Grant No. SEAFBD-2123-WhCoPW-00014 and SEAFBD-2325-WhCoPW-00054). Both grants expire on June 30, 2027. The cost reimbursement agreement and all amendments are with the City of Everson (City), and the City has retained R&E to represent all three small cities.

A cost reimbursement agreement with the City was executed on January 23, 2023. Amendment #1 corrected an error in the contract amount, which was approved by council at \$48,000. Amendment #2 increased the total contracted amount to \$73,000. Amendment #3 proposes to add an additional \$30,000 for a total contract amount of \$103,000. The additional \$30,000 will cover R&E's time on the FLIPSC through the term of the grant contracts, which expire on June 30, 2027. All other terms and conditions of the original contract shall remain in full force and effect. The '21-'23 and '23-'25 FbD grants require a 20% local match by the City.

#### **Funding Amount and Source**

This cost reimbursement agreement amendment proposes to add \$30,000 to the original contract amount for a total contract amount of \$103,000 for participation by the City in the FLIP process through June 30, 2027. This amount will be reimbursed by the '21-'23 or '23-'25 FbD grants and the 20% match will be provided by the City of Everson.

# Amendment No. 3 Whatcom County Contract No. 202301031 COST REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN WHATCOM COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF EVERSON

THIS AMENDMENT is to the Cost Reimbursement Agreement between Whatcom County Flood Control Zone
District and the City of Everson, dated 01/23/23 and designated "Whatcom County Contract No.
<u>202301031</u> ". In consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived, the parties agree to the
following:
This Amendment increases the maximum consideration by \$30,000.00 to a total consideration of \$103,000.00. This Amendment also extends the contract end date to 06/30/27.
Section 3. Payment of the original contract is replaced with the following:
3. PAYMENT
The District will provide payment to the City to reimburse 80 percent (80%) of eligible costs of the City's contracted representative (Reichardt & Ebe Engineering, Inc.) for participation in the FLIP process. Total reimbursement shall be no more than eighty percent (80%) of one-hundred and twenty-eight thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$128,750), equal to one-hundred and three thousand dollars (\$103,000), inclusive of indirect costs. Reimbursement shall be made within thirty (30) days of the District's receipt of the City's reimbursement request. All eligible costs shall be dated no earlier than July 1, 2021.
Section 4. Term of the Agreement is replaced with the following:
4. TERM OF AGREEMENT The period of performance for this Agreement shall be consistent with the performance periods of the 2021-2023 FbD grant (Grant No. SEAFBD-2123-WhCoPW-00014) and the 2023-2025 FbD grant (Grant No. SEAFBD-23-25-WhCoPW-00054), which is July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2027 and July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2027, respectively.
Unless specifically amended by this agreement, all other terms and conditions of the original contract shall remain in full force and effect.
This Amendment takes effect: 06/01/25 , regardless of the date of signature.
