**CLOSING THE VACTOR TRUCK STORAGE BUILDING FUND 379**

**WHEREAS**, on November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Ordinance 2018-072 created the Vactor Truck Storage Building Fund and funded the project; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Road fund 108 contributed \$440,000 towards the project; and,

**WHEREAS**, the project has not incurred any expenditures since 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, section 6.8 of the Whatcom County Home Rule Charter allows for project-based capital budget appropriation ordinances that lapse when the project has been completed for abandoned or when no expenditure or encumbrance has been made for three (3) years; and,

**WHEREAS**, the project fund is no longer needed; and,

**WHEREAS**, the current cash balance in the fund is approximately \$426,509.12; and,

**WHEREAS**, remaining cash in the fund should be returned to the Road fund in the amount of \$426,509.12; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Whatcom County Council that the Vactor Truck Storage Building Fund be dissolved and its remaining cash balance be returned to the Road fund.
