I am a recently retired physician. I practiced for 30 years as a reconstructive surgeon, specializing in the treatment of upper extremity problems in adults and children. I was Assistant Professor of Plastic Surgery and Orthopedic Surgery at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine from 1994-1998. I was Assistant Clinical Professor of Surgery at University of California, San Francisco from 2006-20021. I was the Founder and President of The Hand Center of San Francisco from 1999-2021. I received my B.S. in Psychobiology from UCLA in 1982. I received my M.D. at UCLA in 1987. I completed residency training in Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery at Stanford University School of Medicine from 1987-1993. I completed a Microsurgery Fellowship, AO Traveling Fellowship in Upper Extremity Reconstruction, and a Hand Surgery Fellowship from 1990-1994. I currently serve as a member of the Board of Directors for the Whatcom Million Trees Project. I volunteer as a mentor for Skookum Kids in Whatcom County.

As a health professional I have a deep concern for the needs of our disenfranchised under-resourced citizens. I have a family member with addiction disorder who was unhoused for several years and who had numerous difficulties receiving adequate, coordinated, or successful treatment, which led to her incarceration on several occasions. She eventually was able to receive successful diversion and treatment and has since achieved numerous life accomplishments, including long-term employment, stable housing, and creating a stable family. This allowed her to escape the cycle of addiction/incarceration that so many of our citizens face and have difficulty navigating to a successful outcome. I would like to be able to participate in the Task Force in hope of helping to find and implement similar successful outcomes here in Whatcom County.
