Cyber Security – "Generalized" Update

Cyber Security

Multi-Year

- Significant Focus on Advancing Our Cyber Security Over the Past Year
- Department of Homeland Security (DHS): Cyber Security Services
 - DHS Offers Complimentary Services to Assist State, Local and Tribal Government
 - Regular Scanning and Reporting on Internet-Facing Devices Started in January
- New Protection for E-Mail System
 - . E-Mail is the #1 Vector for the Delivery of Malware
 - Added New Advanced Threat Protection Module to E-Mail System in April
 - System Scans E-Mail Attachments and Links Less Malspam Getting Delivered to Users
- New Vulnerability Scanning
 - Acquired New Software to Scan Devices on Our Internal Network for Vulnerabilities
 - · Internal Vulnerability Scanning Pilot Started in April
- New Anti-Virus Desktop Software
 - Completed the Deployment of New More Robust Anti-Virus Software in July
- Enterprise Backup System Protection
 - · Confirmed Ransomware Protection Enabled in Enterprise Backup System in July
- Cyber Insurance
 - WA Counties Risk Pool Cyber Insurance Claim Limit "Doubled" in October
