Hi Council members:

While reviewing the packet, I noticed an error in Exhibit A (proposed changes to WCC 20.13). On page 36, Exhibit A included the following language: "The County will consider all health affects it legally can, unless preempted."

Rationale: Planning Commission – This provision would allow County to address radio frequency radiation if the U.S. Congress and/or FCC modify federal rules in the future.

This language was proposed by the Planning Commission, but voted down by a 2-5 vote.

The next motion was approved by the Planning Commission adding the following alternative language on page 2 of Exhibit A: "Whatcom County recognizes its requirement to provide for communication services and a commitment to the health of its citizens."

I've corrected Exhibit A (attached) by removing the unapproved language and associated rationale on page 36.
