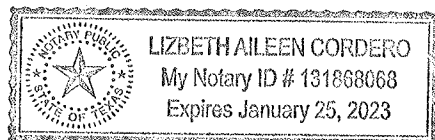
Whatcom County Council will have public hearings, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its September 24, 2019, meeting, or at a later date: **ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT FOR PORTIONS OF EAST SMITH ROAD AND EVERSON GOSHEN ROAD (2019-450):** This ordinance establishes the speed limits as follows: 35 MPH on E. Smith Road, from 1000 feet west of Everson Goshen Road to 1000 feet east of Everson Goshen Road, Sections 25, 26, 35, 36, Township 39 North, Range 3 East, W.M.; 35 MPH on Everson Goshen Road, from 1000 feet north of E. Smith Road to 1000 feet south of E. Smith Road, Sections 25, 26, 35, 36, Township 39 North, Range 3 East, W.M. The County Engineer will install the appropriate signs and the Sheriff and State Patrol will be notified. **ORDINANCE AMENDING WCC 8.13, SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL DISTRICT, REGARDING THE SOLID WASTE EXCISE PRIVILEGE TAX (2019-458):** This ordinance amends WCC 8.13.030, Excise privilege tax levied to implement a revenue neutral conversion of the tax, for solid waste collection companies, from \$8.50 per ton to 3.3% of invoice, thus ensuring that taxes collected exactly equal taxes remitted. **RESOLUTION IN THE MATTER OF THE WHATCOM COUNTY SIX-YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (STIP) FOR THE YEAR 2020 THROUGH 2025 (2019-445):** Each year the County is required to update its Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), per RCW 35.77.010 and RCW 36.81.121. THE STIP includes the capital elements of the 2020-2025 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program and 2020-2033 Fourteen-Year-Ferry Capital Program. The STIP is intended as a planning tool for local, state and federally funded projects and is designed to identify projects for preliminary engineering, right-of-way purchase and/or construction. **RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SIX-YEAR WATER RESOURCES IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (WRIP) FOR THE YEARS 2020-2025 (2019-456):** Resolution by the Whatcom County Flood Control Zone District Board of Su-
