This ordinance establishes a new fund titled Criminal Justice Integrated Case Management Systems Project Fund to be used to account for the revenues and expenditures of the case management system projects with an initial budget of \$600,000.

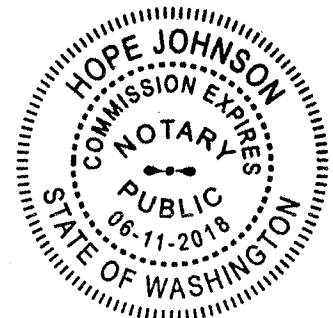

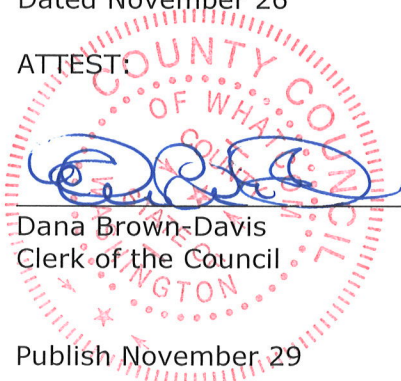
