Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its November 6, 2019 meeting: **ORDINANCE (2019-074) ADOPTING INTERIM ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE SITING, ESTABLISHMENT, AND OPERATION OF TEMPORARY HOMELESS FACILITIES (AB2019-531)**. This ordinance is for Whatcom County to meet public, health, safety and welfare requirements for establishment and processing of applications for temporary homeless facilities in unincorporated Whatcom County Council introduced this ordinance on October 22, 2019. 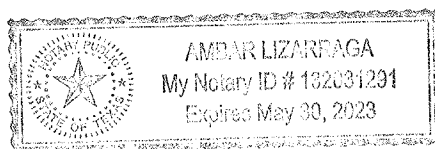
