

Project Background

- 1994 Whatcom County Implemented Oracle JD Edwards World
- Software has Been Upgraded Over the Years but is End-of-Life
- 2018 Council Ordinance Created Financial System Software Fund
 Initial Funding of \$1,750,000
- 2020 SoftResources Needs Assessment (Met w/ All Departments)
 - Upgrade to Latest JD Edwards Software Most Viable Option
 - Oracle JD Edwards <u>EnterpriseOne</u>
- 2020 / 2021 / 2022 Project Interrupted by COVID-19 Global Pandemic
- 2022 Selected iKW Solutions (iKW) Implementation Consultant from RFP
- 2022 Council Approved Adding \$1,604,000 to Project Budget (RFP Experience Provide Insight on Cost of Project)
- 2022 Entered into \$1,225,975 Contract with iKW Solutions

Project Implementation Status

- Early 2023 Kicked Off Project to Upgrade to JD Edwards EnterpriseOne
- Initial Core Team: Finance, HR, IT, Treasurer, Public Works
- Requirements Process Identified Items Which Increased Project Scope
 - Chart of Accounts Needed to be Reorganized
 - Enhancements Needed for Cash & Investment Accounting
 - Enhancements Needed for Junior Tax District Accounting
 - New Module Needed for Grant Accounting
 - New Report Writing Software Needed to Reproduce Current Reports
 - Custom Development for Complex Payroll & Purchasing Forms
- Given Timeline & Staffing Limitations Project Focus Narrowed to Go-Live
 Critical Items
- Deferred Budget Software, Accounts Payable Automation, Advanced Purchase Order Approval Routing, and Integration with Public Works Fleet and Asset Management to a Future Project Phase

- Summer 2023 Initial Configuration of Software Modules
 - Human Resources \ Payroll
 - General Ledger and Reporting
 - Treasurer Special Districts and Investments
 - Grant and Job Cost Accounting
 - Fixed Asset Management
- Fall 2023 Revised Implementation Timeline
 - Not Feasible to Complete Configuration & Testing by End of Year
