5 TEMPORARY INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS
6 ON NOON ROAD AT TEN MILE ROAD AND ON EAST HEMMI ROAD AT NOON ROAD

8 WHEREAS, in compliance with RCW 36.32.120 and 46.61.200, it is found necessary and
9 expedient to install traffic control signs on certain County Roads; and

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11 WHEREAS, East Hemmi Road is submerged several months of the year; and

12
13 WHEREAS, an alternative analysis performed by Public Works recommended raising a
14 portion of the roadway and installing a larger culvert to mitigate flood impacts; and

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16 WHEREAS, design and permitting on the project is now complete and construction of this
17 project is expected to start in the summer of 2021 with completion anticipated in fall 2021; and

18
19 WHEREAS, during construction of this project East Hemmi Road will be closed at the
20 project site and local traffic will be detoured to Hannegan Road, Tenmile Road, and Noon Road;
21 and

23 WHEREAS, Public Works proposes installing temporary stop signs on Noon Road at Ten
24 Mile Road and on East Hemmi Road at Noon Road to improve the safety of these intersections
25 during use of this detour;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Whatcom County Council that temporary
28 stop signs be installed on Noon Road at Ten Mile Road and on East Hemmi Road at Noon Road
29 as shown on Exhibit A, the detour plan for the above-cited project, upon the start of project
30 construction; and

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32 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that upon completion of the project the temporary stop
33 signs will be removed; and

35 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the County Engineer is hereby directed to install the
36 appropriate signs and that the Whatcom County Sheriff be notified by a copy of this ordinance.
