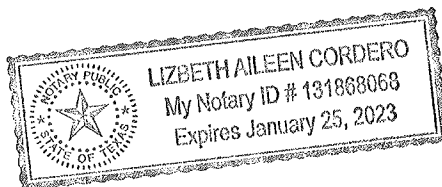
The Whatcom County Council will consider adopting and may amend the following at its September 24, 2019, meeting: **ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROJECT BUDGET FOR THE EAST WHATCOM REGIONAL RESOURCE CENTER EXPANSION PROJECT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$172,000 (AB2019-460)**: This ordinance amends the project budget to secure \$172,000 to complete the EWRRS's second building. The original project budget and subsequent amendments, for a total amended project budget of \$6,384,571. **ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROJECT BUDGET FOR THE TRIAGE CENTER EXPANSION FUND, REQUEST NO. 3 (AB2019-464)**: This ordinance amends the expenditure authority by adding \$1,000,000 to the current amended project budget of \$12,400,000 to a total amended project budget of \$13,400,000. This is contingency funding, along with spending authority, for unanticipated expenses and any complications with the construction of the facility. These funds will only be utilized if necessary. **ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2019 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 12 (AB2019-465)**: This ordinance adds appropriations to: Non Departmental jail medical costs \$362,000; Sheriff \$1,000; from Jail Fund: \$36,531 Electrical work; \$9,000 Fiber cost increase; \$17,000 Medication Assisted treatment program; \$362,000 jail medical services and medication costs; \$172,000 to East Whatcom Regional Resource Center Phase II; \$50,000 Whatcom Unified Emergency Coordination Center model; \$750,000 fund Port of Bellingham Broadband Project; \$1,000,000 Triage Facility project. For a total \$2,759,531. **ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROJECT BUDGET FOR THE BIRCH BAY DRIVE AND PEDESTRIAN FACILITY PROJECT FUND, REQUEST NO. 5 (AB2019-451)**: This ordinance amends the project budget to add an additional amount of \$3,000,000 of expenditure authority for a new current project budget expenditure amount of \$14,450,000. The additional expenditure amount is needed due to budget capacity lost from the extended permitting and R/W phase
