Enclosed is a cost reimbursement agreement amendment between the Whatcom County Flood Control Zone District (FCZD) and the Nooksack Indian Tribe (NIT) for your review and signature.

#### **Requested Action**

Public Works respectfully requests that the County Executive and Council, acting as the FCZD Board of Supervisors, approve an amendment to this Cost Reimbursement Agreement with the NIT to increase budget for participation in the Floodplain Integrated Planning (FLIP) process including participation on the FLIP Steering Committee, FLIP Team, and FLIP Reach Teams.

#### **Background and Purpose**

The NIT has participated in the FLIP planning process since it began in 2017. The FCZD was awarded '21-'23 biennium and '23-'25 biennium Floodplains by Design (FbD) grants from the Department of Ecology for the Nooksack River: Floodplains that Work – Phase 2 and Phase 3 projects, respectively, that includes funding to support participation of NIT staff in the FLIP planning process (Grant No. SEAFBD-2123-WhCoPW-00014 and SEAFBD-2325-WhCoPW-00054). Both grants expire on June 30, 2027

A cost reimbursement agreement with the NIT was executed on January 23, 2023 in the amount of \$24,000 to compensate NIT for their staff time supporting the FLIP. The proposed amendment increases the total contracted amount to \$88,000. The additional \$64,000 will cover NIT's time on the FLIPSC through the term of the grant contracts, which expire on June 30, 2027. All other terms and conditions of the original contract shall remain in full force and effect. The '21-'23 and '23-'25 FbD grants require a 20% local match.

#### **Funding Amount and Source**

This cost reimbursement agreement amendment proposes to add \$64,000 to the original contract amount for a total contract amount of \$88,000. This amount will be reimbursed by the '21-'23 or '23-'25 FbD grants and the 20% match (of \$110,000) will be provided by the NIT.

# Amendment No. 1 Whatcom County Contract No. 202301032 COST REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN WHATCOM COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT AND THE NOOKSACK INDIAN TRIBE

This Amendment increases the maximum consideration by $$64,000.00$ to a total consideration of $88,000.00$ . This Amendment also extends the contract end date to $06/30/27$ .
Section 3. Payment of the original contract is replaced with the following:
3. PAYMENT The District will provide payment to the Nooksack Indian Tribe (NIT) to reimburse 80 percent (80%) of eligible costs for participation in the FLIP process. Total reimbursement shall be no more than eighty percent (80%) of one hundred and ten thousand dollars (\$110,000), equal to eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$88,000), inclusive of indirect costs. Reimbursement shall be made within thirty (30) days of the District's receipt of the NIT's reimbursement request. All eligible costs shall be dated no earlier than July 1, 2021.
Section 4. Term of the Agreement is replaced with the following:
4. TERM OF AGREEMENT The period of performance for this Agreement shall be consistent with the performance periods of the 2021-2023 FbD grant (Grant No. SEAFBD-2123-WhCoPW-00014) and the 2023-2025 FbD grant (Grant No. SEAFBD-23-25-WhCoPW-00054), which is July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2027 and July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2027, respectively.
Unless specifically amended by this agreement, all other terms and conditions of the original contract shall remain in full force and effect.
This Amendment takes effect: 04/01/25 , regardless of the date of signature.
