1a. Description of request:

During the December 2025 flood event, two sections of levees along the Nooksack River, Ritter Road and Bylsma, were damaged. Both of these levees are in the USACE PL 84-99 program wherein the USACE will repair these levees to USACE standards with the local sponsor providing a 20% cost share. The USACE stated their intention to conduct all repairs of damages from the December 2025 flood events throughout the state by October 2026.

The purpose of this supplemental budget request is to create the budget to accept the 20% cost share revenue from the Lynden-Everson Subzone District in Bylsma Levee Repair cost center 19082690.

This is a companion supplemental to 5475- LE cost share to Bylsma Levee Emergency Repair

1b. Primary customers:

2. Problem to be solved:

During the December 2025 flood event, two sections of levees along the Nooksack River, Ritter Road and Bylsma, were damaged. Both of these levees are in the USACE PL 84-99 program wherein the USACE will repair these levees to USACE standards with the local sponsor providing a 20% cost share. USACE needs funding for the cost share in June in order to complete the repairs before the next flood season. Consequently, Public Works utilized funds in the 2026 Flood budget set aside for emergency repairs.

This will enable the LE Subzone to provide timely reimbursement to the Flood Control Zone District for their portion of the cost share.

4b. Measures:

Providing cost share for these levee repairs will allow the repairs to be completed before the next flood season and allow these levees to stay in the PL84-99 program that covers 80% of the cost of repairs. The Lynden-Everson Flood Control Zone District Sub-zone is providing \$30,000 towards the Bylsma repair and Diking District No. 3 is providing \$34,830 towards the Ritter Road repair.
