The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its November 10, 2020 meeting:

ORDINANCE (2020-056) ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 20.72, POINT ROBERTS SPECIAL DISTRICT (AB2020-445): This ordinance proposes amendments to the Whatcom County Code 20.72, Point Robert Special District. This ordinance was introduced October 27, 2020

ORDINANCE (2020-057) GRANTING GORDON MONTGOMERY AND JOHN MILOBAR A FRANCHISE AND THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE, AND AUTHORITY THEREUNDER TO LOCATE, SET, ERECT, LAY, CONSTRUCT, EXTEND, SUPPORT, ATTACH, CONNECT, MAINTAIN, REPAIR, REPLACE, ENLARGE, OPERATE AND USE FACILITIES IN, UPON, OVER, UNDER, ALONG, ACROSS AND THROUGH THE FRANCHISE AREA TO ALLOW FOR THE PROVISION OF SEWER SERVICES. (AB2020-310): This ordinance grants non-exclusive twenty-five (25) year franchise to construct, erect, alter, lay, support, connect, improve, renew, replace, repair, operate and maintain a sanitary sewer main upon, under, over, across and along certain roads and other areas in Whatcom County, Washington. The "Franchise Area" is that portion of Semiahmoo Drive extending southerly from Shearwater Road 2,000 feet and located in Township 40 North, Range 1 West, Sections 10 and 15. Council introduced the above at its August 5, 2020 meeting.

ORDINANCE (2020-058) AMENDING THE PROJECT BUDGET FOR THE CIVIC CENTER IMPROVEMENT FUND, REQUEST NO. 1 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,350,000 (AB2020-449): This ordinance requests \$4,350,000 of additional budget authority to provide for life safety and energy efficiency improvements throughout the entire building, in addition to fourth floor renovations, for a total project budget amount of \$6,850,000.
