### **Define 6-Yr Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP):**

- Planning document for Capital Transportation Improvements w/in Road ROW.
- Sections/Div Involved - All Engr Sections; M&O; Stormwater; River & Fld.
- Involves a Public Input process as well as Coord w/Tribes, Other Agencies, School Distr, Utilities, and Adv Committees (WCOG/TTAG, BPAC,).
- Shows Projects w/imprv type, limits, phases, utilities, envir, R/W, funding, costs and year.
- Works in tandem with Budget.
- Adopted by Resolution w/majority vote.
- First year becomes Annual Construction Program – note some planned expenditures will require outside funding.

### **Overview of our Spreadsheet and Ancillary Documents**

- Divided into 5 major categories - Roads; Bridges/Fish Passage; Ferry; Multimodal; Yearly Capital.
- Addresses key projects in each category, but also addresses: most deficient bridges; flood repairs from Jan 2021, bike & pedestrian projects, Swift Crk, ADA Priorities from Transition Plan, and road components of Stmwtr and River&Flood capital programs.
- First 3-yrs generally should be solvent = Revenues meet or exceed expenditures.
- Other documents not present today, but part of Resolution Pkg, are: Project Narratives; Bridge Report; 14-Yr Capital Ferry Plan; Revenue/Expenditures; Financial Distr by Year. Define briefly as needed.

**Hit key Projects in each Capital Area - Roads, Bridges/FP, Ferry, Yearly:**

- Near Term Projects typically are shown near top of each category.
- Go over several projects in each category; highlight Funding prog's and proj goals.
- Stress balance in projects listed – good mix of road, bridge, fish passage, bike and ped, ferry, etc....
- The program still contains a larger % of *Paver* projects (rdwys w/ 20+ years on their hot mix asphalt surface) due to being excellent candidates for Stimulus Pkgs - quick design, no R/W or Envir, great bang for buck, all in-house, primary arterials/collectors and freight/goods routes. Look for grants.
